

	Household refuse subject to a fee	Combustible waste such as plastic, leather goods, hoover bags, hygiene articles, nappies, light bulbs, cat litter etc.	Everything that can otherwise be disposed of (processed, recycled).	In the official waste bags or with fee stamps.	Collections on Thursday, the collection route may change at short notice, provide collected items from 7 a.m. onwards. Exceptions: Saturday, 03 January (after New Year) Saturday, 16 May 2026 (after Ascension) Saturday, 06 June 2026 (after Corpus Christi)
	Bulky goods chargeable	Everything that does not fit the official bags and does not fall under the other waste Furniture disassembled and bundled.	Everything that can otherwise be disposed of. Especially cookers, refrigerators, sports equipment, stone furniture, metals, etc. For items in good condition, also use the services of the second-hand shops.	With official bulky goods stamps. Bulky goods and bulky individual items chargeable	Bulky individual items that cannot be included in the regular Thursday collection or the special bulky item collections should be taken directly to the waste incineration plant in Turgi (www.kvaturgi.ch , tel. 056 201 91 11) or handed over to a transport company for disposal against payment of the transport and disposal costs. Please note the offers of the second-hand shops.
KVA Turgi chargeable	The Turgi waste incineration plant is open to private individuals as follows: Mon. - Fri. 07.30 - 11.00 and 13.30 - 16.00, Sat. 08.00 - 12.00 (latest entry 15 minutes before closing).

Animal carcasses Do free	Small animal carcasses from households can be brought to the regional collection point of the city of Baden, commercial zone "im Grund", in Baden-Dättwil from Monday to Sunday during 24 hours. The animal carcasses are to be deposited unpacked in the container at the carcass collection point. In case of emergency, please contact the construction service of our municipality, tel. 056 282 59 10 (office hours)/079 405 04 83 (on-call service). Farm animals and other large animals (200 kg or more) should be reported to GZM Extraktionswerk AG in Lyss for removal, tel. 032 387 47 87 (office hours)/032 384 33 33 (on-call service)

Christmas trees, free	In January, Christmas trees can be given to the green waste collection free of charge. All foreign materials (tinsel etc.) must be removed.
Compost free	The municipality distributes compost from Kompogas Bioriko AG to the population free of charge. Small quantities of compost can be handed in at the supervised collection point at the Technical Centre, Nussbaumen. Please note the opening hours of the collection point.
